*Understanding Terrorism: Interpersonal, Organizational and Media Communication Perspectives* This course will explore the social scientific study of terrorism. We begin from the empirical reality that terrorism is communicatively constituted violence and anchor the study of terrorism in the study of communication and conflict. With this as a base, we will identify the key theoretical issues in the contemporary terrorism literature and examine the potential contributions that interpersonal, intergroup, organizational and media studies and communication theories in general can offer to the understanding of terrorism and conflict.
